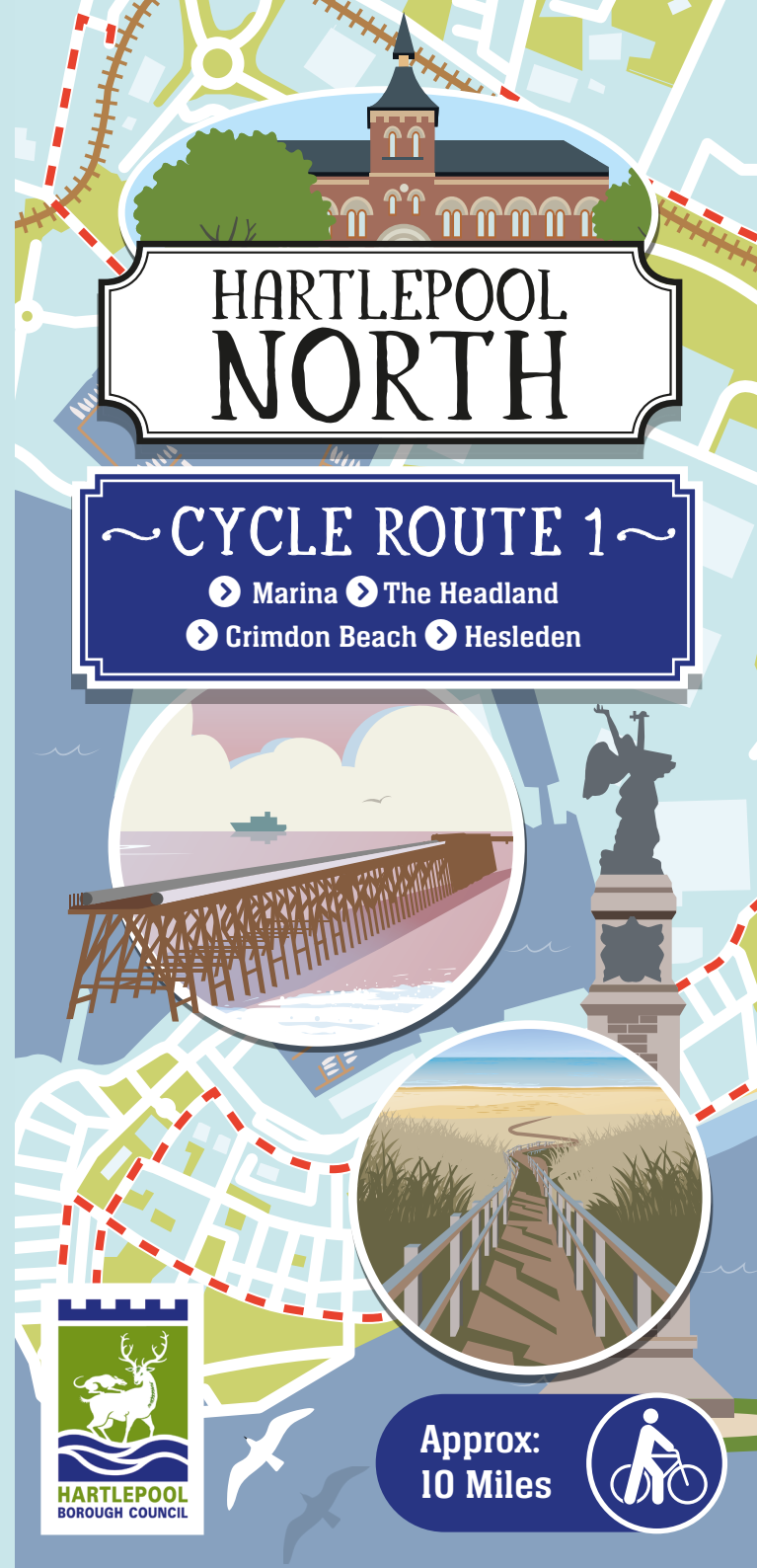

NORTH CYCLE TRAIL

APPROX : 10 MILES

This is a medium difficulty cycling route with some hills and a mix of roads and traffic-free paths. Beginning at Hartlepool Railway Station you'll visit The Marina, historic Headland, Heugh Gun Battery and Crimdon beach before heading to Hesleden using the former Hart to Haswell railway.
